Letter of Invitation

Over the last few decades the mineral industry has improved its accountability and transparency and various Codes applicable to the mineral industry have been introduced and improved. The major Codes used internationally, especially by the industry and by Stock Exchanges, include the 2012 JORC Code and the 2015 VALMIN Code.

It's important that anyone associated with evaluating a mineral project, doing an IPO, interested in investing in a mineral project or company or professional parties in a mineral company IPO exercise, have a basic working knowledge of matters related to the various Codes and Stock Exchange Listing Rules.
